This is the first phase in rebuilding one of the world's most famous and picturesque narrow gauge railways, the legendary Lynton & Barnstaple railway, closed as long ago as 1935.

A one-mile section has now been reopened allowing visitors to travel by train along the original L&B route above the Heddon Valley near Parracombe in South West England's Exmoor National Park.

Today's visitors can experience a taste of what will one day be one of the ultimate heritage narrow gauge railway experiences of the world.

The staff and volunteers of the L&B all work together to create the type of atmosphere that could have been found on the L&B in the past.
